## BNA BOARD VOTES TO OPPOSE ALDI PLANS

At a joint meeting of North Winton Village and Browncroft neighbors on June 11th at St. John's Church the Aldi representative presented revisions to the initial plans for construction of their store to be built behind the Tops Gas Station at Winton and Blossom. City Zoning Department staff present were Mitch Rowe, Director, and Zina Lagonegro, Sr. Planner.

The new plans showed that the building was brought closer to the sidewalk, more window area was added, as was more landscaping, Some parking was reduced. See the new rendering below.

However the building size, signage and parking still exceed the zoning code requirements necessitating Planning Commission and Zoning Board of Appeal hearings. The Zoning Board of Appeals hearing is scheduled for July 23rd. The Planning Commission date is still under discussion.

The Browncroft Neighborhood Association Board has voted to write a letter in opposition to the project based on its incompatibility with the commercial-1 (C-1) zoning of the parcels at that corner.
